HB 2556 A

Provides requirements for employer deductions for erroneous overpayments of wages for employees who are not subject to collective bargaining agreement.

HB 2921 A

Requires hospitals to file certain reports showing demographics of hospitals' workforces with Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries for posting to Bureau of Labor and Industries' website.

HB 3028 A

Prohibits employer from requiring employee to use vacation, sick or annual leave for time spent by employee as appointed member of state board or commission.

HB 3532

Allows Arts Program to use up to five percent of value of Trust for Cultural Development Account for certain administrative purposes.
