Work Session

SB 221

Establishes Electronic Permitting System Subaccount.

SB 220

Requires payment of additional 25 percent surcharge on certain assessments by State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries.

SB 222

Authorizes State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries to accept payments by credit card and to add fee to credit card transactions.

SB 57

Removes prohibition against sale, offer for sale, maintenance or control of female cattle of beef breed that have not been vaccinated against brucellosis.

SB 835

Directs Environmental Quality Commission to adopt rules authorizing single-family dwelling and accessory dwelling unit constructed on same lot or parcel to be permanently connected to same subsurface sewage disposal system or alternative sewage disposal system.

SB 812

Allows local government to prohibit takeoff and landing of unmanned aircraft systems in parks owned by local government.

SB 679 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Parks and Recreation Department for continued development of Oregon Coast Trail.

SB 753 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Forestry Department for purposes related to plant disease Sudden Oak Death.

SB 899 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys to Invasive Species Council, out of General Fund, for certain purposes.

SB 161

Requires Department of State Lands to study matters relating to management of Elliott State Forest.

SB 872

Instructs State Forestry Department to endeavor to partner with federal agencies to undertake certain activities in federal forests related to fire prevention and request that federal agencies fund activities.

SB 1006 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to Umpqua Fishery Enhancement Derby to conduct fish habitat restoration projects at specified locations.
