SB 292 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/4/2023 MEETING: Narrows applicability of requirement that members of district school board must file verified statement of economic interest to only those members of districts with specified number of students or districts that are sponsors of virtual public charter schools.

Public Hearing

SB 1087

Establishes standards for establishment of farm cafes on lands in Lane County zoned for exclusive farm use.

HB 3141

Provides that Governor's appointment of chief administrative law judge is subject to confirmation by Senate.

Work Session

SB 999 A

Requires Bureau of Labor and Industries to study issues relating to different leave laws under which individuals may take time off of work for qualifying reasons.
