SB 167

Alters dates by which special district recall petitions must be filed and verified.

SB 177

Requires state agencies to produce materials relevant to audits conducted by Secretary of State.

Work Session

SB 612 **

Establishes Indigenous Language Justice Fund.

SB 999 A

Clarifies meaning of "one-year period" for purposes of determining amount of unpaid family leave that eligible employee is entitled to take within any given one-year period.

SB 106

Requires Department of Human Services to study disposition rates of child abuse investigations. SB 556

Prohibits public bodies from seizing certain benefits and resources intended for persons in custody of Department of Human Services.

SB 570

Requires Department of Human Services to contract with up to two agencies providing agency with choice services.

HB 3141

Provides that Governor's appointment of chief administrative law judge is subject to confirmation by Senate.
