SB 70 A

Modifies requirements for residential rezoning of lands within Eastern Oregon Border Economic Development Region.

SB 678

Establishes state policy that benefits from offshore wind energy development go to local and regional communities, ecosystems and environments and economies and that interconnection of offshore energy projects be carried out in manner that promotes electric grid reliability and resilience.

HB 3382 B

Allows local government to adopt land use exception to Goal 16 under certain conditions for applications for deep draft navigation channel improvements in Oregon International Port of Coos Bay.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2004 A

Establishes ranked choice voting as voting method for selecting winner of nomination for and election to offices of President of United States, United States Senator, Representative in Congress, Governor, Secretary of State, State Treasurer and Attorney General.

HB 2107 A

Extends automatic voter registration to Oregon Health Authority in certain circumstances.

HB 3014 B

Directs State Board of Education to adopt rules that allow for reimbursement of school district expenses incurred for alternative transportation costs.
