#### **Work Session**

HB 2295

Broadens public contracting preference for businesses that service-disabled veterans own to include all veteran-owned businesses.

HB 2146 A

Provides that portion of U.S. Highway 30, beginning where highway intersects with U.S. Highway 101 and ending at Idaho state line, shall also be known as Oregon Gold Star Families Memorial Highway.

HB 2147 A

Directs governing body of each county to designate person to ensure interment of unclaimed cremated remains of veteran or survivor of veteran.

#### **Public Hearing**

HB 2490

Exempts from required disclosure records concerning cybersecurity plans, devices and systems, including contractual and insurance records setting forth specifications, applications and coverages.

HB 2806 A

Authorizes governing body of public body to meet in executive session to consider matters relating to safety of governing body, public body staff and public body volunteers and to security of public body facilities and meeting spaces, and relating to cyber security infrastructure and responses to cyber security threats.

HB 3127 A

Identifies certain covered vendors.
