Work Session

HB 2144 A

Removes requirement that remains of individual serving in Armed Forces of the United States who was killed in line of duty and formerly designated prisoner of war or missing in action, and whose remains are recovered and identified, be returned to Oregon to receive Fallen Hero roadside memorial recognition.

HB 3421 A

Requires official ceremony or other event held by state government to commemorate Memorial Day or Veterans Day to be held on legal holiday.

HCR 28

Recognizes and honors Lieutenant Colonel Herman A. "Mac" MacDonald, Jr. (1929-2022), for his service to his state, country and fellow veterans.
