SUMMARY

Creates crime of controlled substances homicide. Punishes by maximum of 10 years' imprisonment, \$250,000 fine, or both.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2023 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 475.752 to 475.980.
- 6 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) A person commits the crime of controlled sub-7 stances homicide if:
- 8 (a) The person unlawfully delivers a controlled substance in vio-
- 9 lation of ORS 475.752, 475.810, 475.812, 475.820, 475.822, 475.830, 475.832,
- 10 475.850, 475.852, 475.870, 475.872, 475.880, 475.882, 475.890, 475.892, 475.904
- 11 **or 475.906**;

- 12 (b) The controlled substance is subsequently used by the individual 13 to whom the controlled substance was delivered;
- 14 (c) The use of the controlled substance results in the death of the 15 individual; and
- 16 (d) The person knew, or should have known, that the use of the 17 controlled substance would likely cause the death of the individual.
- 18 (2) Controlled substances homicide is a Class B felony.
- 19 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2023 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date 20 on which the 2023 regular session of the Eighty-second Legislative
