Revises statutes to maintain accuracy. Corrects punctuation and grammatical errors. Conforms language to legislative form and style. Removes obsolete references, standardizes terminology, and removes statutes from inappropriate series. Makes other nonsubstantive corrections.

BACKGROUND:

In every long session, the Office of Legislative Counsel Introduces a "reviser's bill" to make nonsubstantive, corrective, and technical changes to Oregon law. Senate Bill 316 would be this session's reviser's bill.
