Measure Description:

Provides that unused portion of amount of pass-through revenue bonds authorized for issuance in preceding biennium carries forward until legislation authorizing amount of pass-through revenue bonds for current biennium is enacted.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Bonding, State Treasurer, Housing and Community Services Department, Oregon Business Development Department, Legislative Assembly, Department of Administrative Services

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Finance and Revenue to the Senate Committee on Housing and Development.

Senate Bill 225 provides that any unused portion of pass-through revenue bonds authorized for issuance in a prior biennium carry forward until new legislation is enacted to authorize a new amount of pass-through revenue bonds in the current biennium.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Senate Committee on Housing and Development.
