- 26.59% in D4 drought
- 118° heat dome (44°+)
- Ice storm
- Flooding
- Wildfires



SB 892 (2021 2nd Special Session)

- Established one time ad-hoc disaster program
- Federal program uncertainty
- Timely implementation and streamline accessibility



Oregon Disaster Assistance Program



- 3-year income average
 - 90%/95% of income
 - \$125k/\$150k
 - Livestock adjustment
- Financial Institutions
 - Bank of Eastern Oregon
 - Columbia Bank
 - Old West Federal Credit Union
 - Umpqua Bank
- Two (2) Rounds of Applications
