Measure Description:

Creates Oregon personal income tax subtraction for amounts received from renting a room in the taxpayer's principal residence. Limits subtraction to \$12,000 per room rented per tax year and requires rent received per room to not exceed \$1,000 for any month. Requires same individual to pay and occupy a rented room for at least three consecutive calendar months during the tax year. Applies to tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2024, and before January 1, 2030.

Revenue Impact:
