Information Requested

- Please provide the number of calls/contacts received by FACT Oregon about shortened school
 days and, if available, a description of the inquiry regarding shortened school days, from 2016present. It would be helpful if you could present those numbers based on the quarter or year
 the calls/contacts were received and if those numbers could be deduplicated (i.e., a family that
 had multiple contacts about shorted school days would only be counted the first time they
 contacted FACT Oregon).
- 2. Without providing any personally identifiable information, for each call/contact about shortened school days, please provide any of the following information that is readily available about the student or family: county, school district, disability, age, gender, race, number of contacts.
- 3. If shortened school day inquiries are a searchable element in FACT Oregon's database, please explain when and why FACT Oregon introduced it into that database.
- 4. If you know, please provide, in whatever form is most convenient, any additional existing information in your possession regarding any common fact patterns that FACT Oregon's Family Resource Specialists have noted in the use of shortened school days.
- 5. Please provide, in whatever form is most convenient, any further existing information you think would be useful in determining the magnitude and scope of shortened school days in Oregon.



Information Provided

FACT Oregon has compiled the information provided below in response to the request for information dated July 1, 2021.

Background

FACT Oregon began collecting information on shortened school days in or around the summer of 2015 when our support team anecdotally reported a perceived increase of requests for support regarding this topic. Initially only able to capture the information in a "note", a "checkbox" within our database was created around fall of 2015, for a staff member to select if shortened day was part of the support request with a family and/or a community partner. This checkbox addition has since made it easier to capture and pull trend data.

The information is being provided with data as of June 30, 2021, and it is important to note that our database has undergone significant work to ensure data integrity, including removing duplicate entries or duplicate accounts, but it is an ongoing process.

Any demographic data is self-reported by the person requesting support. Because it is not always reported or captured, and because of the varying size of student populations across counties/districts, we are not providing disaggregated data that could compromise individual privacy issues. The information below includes overall demographic representations for requests captured within a specific year, without aligning demographics to individuals. (i.e., Primary Language in 2016-2016 includes "English" and "Spanish" – but we are not providing a count of families who speak English or Spanish.)

The process

- FACT Oregon used the 6-month period of January 1-June 30, 2016, and annual periods thereafter through June 30, 2021, to pull reports that included:
 - Selection of Shortened School Day
 - Notes that included the phrases of:
 - Shortened day
 - Short day
 - Reduced school day

 - o Then searched and cross referenced with the Shortened Day Report
 - Used to determine the number of all behavior support requests
- Selection of all support requests
 - o Then searched and cross referenced with the Shortened Day Report
 - Used to determine the number of all support requests
- All reports were then deduplicated, and the first contact regarding shortened day is what is used for the data.
