Question: Can a small school district sponsor a public charter school and receive the percentage of the charter school's SSF while the charter school locates campuses in other districts but not in a way that the sponsor loses enrollment?

## Response:

Virtual public charter schools currently do this. Currently, there are no examples of this happening with non-virtual charter schools in Oregon, but it is possible with ORS 332.158 as currently written.
