

Oregon Public Employees Retirement System Expenditure History + 2023-25 Governor's Budget




Full-time Equivalents


Non-Limited and Employer Incentive Funds (in millions)

Oregon Public Employees Retirement System 2023-25 Governor's Budget/ Revised costs

Approved Policy Packages:

- POP 101: Senate Bill 1049 Projects \$18.1 million
- POP 102: Staff to support existing core systems- \$1.9 million
- POP 103: Core retirement system modernization- \$9.6 million
- POP 105: Hardware replacement and licensing applications- \$2.2 million
- POP 109: Addressing Qualifying/non-Qualify backlog- \$0.5 million
- Pops: 107,108,110 &111: Staffing to address additional agency support and workload- \$0.7 million
- DAS Adjustments

Revised projected costs:

• POP 101: Senate Bill 1049 – revised costs- \$20.1 million
