Measure Description:

Prohibits person from using specified types of animals in traveling animal act.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Cities, Criminal Justice Commission, Department of Fish and Wildlife, District Attorneys, Oregon Youth Authority, Counties, Department of Corrections, Department of Justice, Judicial Department, Public Defense Services Commission

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transferring the measure from the House Committee on Economic Development and Small Business to the House Committee on Judiciary.

The measure creates a new crime for persons who use specific animals in a traveling animal act and is categorized as a Class B misdemeanor.
