Appropriates \$250,000 from the General Fund for distribution to Southern Coos Hospital and Health Care Center for engineering costs related to facility expansion. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

BACKGROUND:

The Southern Coos Hospital and Health Care Center (<u>link</u> to website) is a small, rural hospital owned and operated by the Southern Coos Health District and located in Bandon, Oregon. Currently licensed for 21 beds, the hospital was granted Critical Access Hospital status in November of 2000 while maintaining its designation as a full-service, general acute hospital.
