

SB 3 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY

WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Adds one credit of future planning to statutory high school graduation requirements for students in the class of 2025 and subsequent graduating classes. Establishes program requirements for future planning courses. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued.

FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Senate Bill 744, enacted in 2021, required the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) to study high school graduation requirements and make recommendations for any possible changes. That [report](#), issued on September 1, 2022, recommended adding a future planning credit requirement for high school graduation. Senate Bill 3 adds a future planning credit requirement to the statutory list of credits required for high school graduation.
