

**FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION**

**Measure: HB 3221**

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**Measure Description:**

Increases amounts of moneys that are not considered Local Revenues for purposes of State School Fund distributions to school districts.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Education, School Districts

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Education to the House Committee on Revenue.

House Bill 3221 modifies amounts not included in local revenue calculations for State School Fund distribution calculations. The measure takes effect on passage.

Currently, some local option taxes are excluded from the calculation of local revenues that are used to determine a school district’s allocation from the State School Fund. House Bill 4117 (2018) increased the cap on the amount excluded from the local revenue calculation. The measure further increases that cap.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Revenue.

Further Analysis Required
