Measure Description:

Provides that certified parole and probation officer employed by State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision qualifies as police officer under Public Employees Retirement System.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Public Employees Retirement System, Department of State Police, Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Natural Resources to the Senate Committee on Judiciary.

The measure allows certified parole and probation officers employed by the Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision (BPPPS) to qualify as police officer under the Public Employees Retirement System (PERS). In addition, the measure allows a certified parole and probation officer who is employed by BPPPS on the effective date of the measure, to be entitled to PERS services as a police officer for all service performed before, on or after the effective date of the measure.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Senate Committee on Judiciary.
