



Licensed Capacity by Type:Pre-COVID to Current

76% of Licensed Capacity exists in Center-Based Programs (CC)

Compared to December 2019, we see:

28% decrease in small family home licensed capacity (RF)

9% increase in large family home capacity (CF)

3% increase in center-based capacity (CC)
