
### **Emerging Issues**

#### Department of Early Learning and Care Budget Milestones








#### 2021-23 LAB to 2023-25 Current Service Level

- <u>Build Existing Current Service Level budget</u> within the Oregon Department of Education and the Oregon Department of Human Services
- <u>Transfer \$1,175 million and 300 positions</u> out of the Oregon Department of Education budget and into DELC
- <u>Transfer \$129 million and 32 positions</u> out of the ODHS to DELC for Inclusive Partners program, ERDC, Child Care policy, and Direct Pay Unit




#### Department of Early Learning and Care 2023-25 Current Service Level and Governor's Budget






#### Department of Early Learning and Care 2023-25 Governor's Budget

#### Agency Budget by Expenditure Category (in millions)










#### Department of Early Learning and Care Revenue Sources





# Department of Early Learning and Care 2023-25 Governor's Budget Investments

- Makes targeted investments in Early Learning programs
  - Additional funding for provider rates to stabilize supply and value the workforce
  - Includes funding for Inclusionary Supports, summer hours for Preschool Promise, Healthy Families Oregon Lincoln County and community transportation
- Employment Related Day Care Enhancements
  - Allows for increased rates for providers and limited caseload growth
  - Supports ERDC transfer from Oregon Department of Human Services
  - Funding for ERDC navigators and supports for families and providers to participate in ERDC



## Department of Early Learning and Care 2023-25 Governor's Budget Investments – cont.

- Program Quality Assurance and Operations staffing
  - Seven positions for Quality Assurance
  - 13 positions for Operational needs to launch the new department
- Healthy Families Oregon database solution
- Family and Provider Engagement funding
- Research and Evaluation funding
- Early Literacy and Child Care Facilities investments in other state agencies

Adjustment from Governor's Recommended Budget

 Moves Infrastructure and Business technical assistance for child care providers from OBDD to DELC



# Department of Early Learning and Care 2023-25 Governor's Budget

Governor's budget program savings/cost decreases

- Recognizes savings in the Grant in Aid budget
- Recognizes savings in Employment Related Day Care utilization
- Eliminates one, vacant Operations and Policy Analyst 4 position
- Adjustments for the Department of Administrative Services and Attorney General costs

Governor's budget program reductions

- Targeted reductions in Services and Supplies costs
- Additional vacancy savings due to vacant positions
