Question & Answer For Transportation Grant Presentation

Question: Could you point us to recent legislative attempts to change transportation funding for schools?

Response:

HB 2693 (2017) was the first attempt to create the special grant that was mentioned at the informational meeting by Mike Wiltfong; this idea eventually passed in 2018 (HB 4130). The discussion leading up to HB 2693 focused on opening up the transportation grant; under Representative McKeown's leadership, there were many work group meetings to land at what was passed as HB 4130 in 2018.

The transit tax passed in 2017 (<u>HB 2017</u>) and then was modified to include youth passes in 2018 (<u>HB 4059</u>). There have been many conversations over the years regarding moving transit passes into the State School Fund as well.
