Analysis:

HB 3222 appropriates \$2 million General Fund to the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) to distribute to the High Desert Partnership. Funds are to be used to design and implement projects on the Silvies River Floodplain, Donner und Blitzen River Floodplain, Malheur Lake, and in the Malheur National Wildlife Refuge that restore or maintain wet meadow, wetland, and lake conditions., Funds are also be used for research, public engagement, and support of collaborative partnerships related to these projects. The measure declares an emergency and takes effect on passage.

There is minimal cost for DAS to distribute these funds.

This measure warrants a subsequent referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means to consider the impact on the State’s General Fund.
