HB 5019 is an appropriation bill to provide funding to address the homelessness emergency declared by Executive Order 23-02, to address homelessness in the OR-505 Oregon Balance of State Continuum of Care, and to support services to homeless youth.

The dash 3 amendment appropriates a net \$128.2 million to the Housing and Community Services Department; \$1.6 million to the Department of Emergency Management; and \$19.9 million to the Department of Human Services. \$30.6 million in funds from the Housing and Community Services Department's 2021-23 budget are repurposed to support these efforts.

The Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee recommends adoption of a budget note directing the Housing and Community Services Department to report quarterly to Ways and Means and housing policy committees with information on resources and outcomes related to these investments in each continuum of care region.

The Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee recommends HB 5019 be amended by the –3 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
