WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Appropriates \$50,000,000 from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to Trillium Family Services for construction of facilities for Oregon Center for Child, Family and Community Health.

FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

-1 **Replaces measure.** Authorizes State Treasurer to issue lottery bonds in an amount that produces \$50 million net proceeds for distribution to Trillium Family Services for construction of facilities for Oregon Center for Child, Family and Community Health.

BACKGROUND:

According to Mental Health America, Oregon ranks last among states in youth mental health. This means that youth in Oregon have a higher prevalence of mental illness and lower rates of access to care.

House Bill 2451 would appropriate \$50,000,000 to assist in the construction of facilities for the Oregon Center for Child, Family and Community Health.
