Completion of ARPA funded projects






Oregon Business Development Department Expenditure History + 2023-25 Governor's Budget






Agency Budget by Expenditure Category (in millions)

Governor's Investments

- New childcare industry business technical assistance and infrastructure assistance
- Provides match to leverage federal programs, including the semiconductor industry
- Enhances Technical Assistance Program and Rural Opportunity Initiative funding
- Enhances the services of the Certification Office for Business Inclusion and Diversity (COBID)
- Provides Oregon Broadband office with necessary staffing to fulfill its mission and receive additional federal funds





Governor's Investments (continued)

- Recapitalizes the Special Public Works Fund (SPWF) and provides matching funds for specific programs related to the SPWF
- Recapitalizes the Seismic Rehabilitation Grant Program
- Carries forward funding from projects began in the 2021-23 biennium that will not be complete by the end of the biennium
- Continues modernization of the Economic Development
 Management System (EDMS) for economic development





Adjustment from Governor's Budget

 Moves child care business technical assistance program from OBDD to Department of Early Learning and Care (DELC) - \$10 million
