Measure Description:

Removes provisions of property tax exemption for community solar projects that restrict exemption to proportion owned by residential customers or leased by residential subscribers. Clarifies that the existing property tax exemption are effective through the 2023-24 tax year. Clarifies that the removed provisions of the property tax exemption for community solar projects take effect in the 2024-25 tax year.
