**Measure Description:**

Defines paramilitary activity. Authorizes Attorney General to bring a civil action if there is reasonable cause that a person or group has engaged in, or is about to engage in, paramilitary activity.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Cities, Counties, Department of Justice, Oregon Judicial Department, Confederated Tribes of Siletz, Confederated Tribes of Coos, Lower Umpqua and Siuslaw Indians, Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs, Cow Creek Band of Umpqua Indians, Higher Education Coordinating Commission, Office of the Governor, Oregon Military Department, Special Districts Association of Oregon, Department of Fish and Wildlife, Burns Paiute Tribe, Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde, Confederated Tribes of Umatilla Indian Reservation, Coquille Indian Tribe, Department of State Police, Klamath Tribes, Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission, School Districts

**Analysis:**
