Measure Description:

Defines "active service," "active service of the state" and "state active duty." Expands authority of Adjutant General, with approval of Governor, to order members of organized militia into active service of the state.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Administrative Services, Department of Justice, Department of State Police, Judicial Department, Office of the Governor, Oregon Military Department

Analysis:
