Attached are the recommendations from the Legislative Fiscal Office (LFO) for the Office of the Public Records Advocate (PRA)

The 2023-25 LFO recommended budget for the Office of the Public Records Advocate is two positions (2.00 FTE) and \$900,101 Other Funds. This is a \$183,296, or 25.6%, increase from 2021-23 legislatively approved budget of \$716,805 Other Funds.

Note that the 2019-21 and 2021-23 budgets for the Office of the Public Records Advocate were included in the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) budget. SB 106 (2017) created the role of the Public Records Advocate (PRA) and the budget for performing the duties of the PRA was housed in DAS. For the 2017-19 biennium, SB 106 appropriated \$633,187 General Fund to DAS to be expended for the Office of the Public Records Advocate and to support the Public Records Advisory Council. For the 2019-21 and 2021-23 biennia, the expenses for the Office were paid through DAS assessments. SB 500 (2021) established the Office of the PRA as an independent office within the executive department, separate and distinct from any other state agency. The 2023-25 biennium budget is the first time the Office submitted a budget request as an independent agency.

The 2023-25 LFO recommended budget includes:

- Technical packages to create the Office of the Public Records Advocate as a new standalone agency by establishing a \$726,437 Other Funds expenditure limitation and authorizing two positions (2.00 FTE).
- \$173,664 Other Funds to provide the Office with sufficient services and supplies expenditure limitation.

Package 070 Revenue Shortfalls

Package Description This package recognizes that the PRA does not have a dedicated funding stream at Current Service Level and reduces the agency budget. The agency budget is reduced to zero and two positions (2.00 FTE) are eliminated. The agency has proposed to restore this reduction with a new funding stream in a policy package (Package 101 – Funding for New Agency). As submitted, this package would have reduced the agency Services and Supplies budget by \$1 more than the expenditure limitation established in the 060 package. The analyst modified this package by \$1 in Services in Supplies, to avoid having a negative budget.

<u>Package Description</u> This package establishes a funding stream for the PRA and restores the reductions reflected in the 070 package. The funding approved is 100 percent Other Funds as an assessment based on FTE. SB 510 (2023) directs and authorizes the PRA to use a similar assessment model used by the Department of Administrative Services and the Oregon Ethics Commission.
