Measure Description:

Directs Oregon Medical Board to support alliance program for family medicine residency training programs in this state.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Administrative Services, Oregon Health and Science University

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

Costs related to the measure may require budgetary action - See analysis.

Summary of Expenditure Impact:

Analysis: The measure with the -3 amendment appropriates \$5 million to the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) for distribution to the Area Health Education Center at the Oregon Health Science University (OHSU) to promote family medicine residency training programs and increase training for residents in maternal and reproductive health care and develop programming for the family medicine residency training program directors, faculty and residents.

If the measure becomes law, DAS will transfer \$5 million General Fund to OHSU to be used by the Area Health Education Center program as directed by the measure. The measure permits the Area Health Education Center program to spend up to five percent of the funds for administrative costs.
