Measure 110 is intentional in funding addiction recovery services that are typically not covered by Medicaid, helping ensure more access to care and less Oregonians falling through the cracks of the system.

 <h2>Overdose Prevention</h2>	<p>*Harm Reduction, *Sobering</p>
 <h2>Addiction Recovery Services</h2>	<p>*Outreach, *Screening, *Assessment, *Peer Support, *Transitional Housing/Rental Assistance</p>
 <h2>Clinical Treatment</h2>	<p>Clinical Therapy, Outpatient, *Detox, Residential Inpatient, Hospitalization (<i>These services can <u>all</u> be paid for with M110 funds when a person is uninsured or otherwise unable to pay.</i>)</p>
 <h2>Recovery Maintenance and Support</h2>	<p>*Peer Support, *Housing, *Supportive Employment, *Medication Assisted Treatment, *Permanent, Recovery and Supportive Housing</p>
