Definitions



- **DoD Military Retirement (Administered by DoD)** Service for 20 years of military service(Includes Some exceptions for early retirement.)
- **DoD Disability Retirement (Administered by DoD)** A military service member in an active component or on active duty for more than 30 days who are found unfit for duty is entitled to disability retired pay for in-service disabilities
- Veterans Pension (Administered by USDVA) The Veterans Pension program provides monthly payments to wartime Veterans who meet certain age or disability requirements, and who have income and net worth within certain limits.
