- Cost allocation


Cash flow and cost allocation

Oregon Department of Emergency Management Expenditure History + 2023-25 Governor's Budget








Oregon Department of Emergency Management 2023-25 Governor's Budget

Agency Budget by Expenditure Category (in millions)



Oregon Department of Emergency Management Revenue Sources

Federal Funds revenue sources:

- Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) grants
- U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) grants

Other Funds revenue sources:

- General obligation bonds for State Preparedness and Incident Response Equipment (SPIRE) grants
- Communications Excise Tax





Oregon Department of Emergency Management Governor's Budget Investments

Strengthen new agency operations and structure

- Close operational gaps and complete establishment
- Prepare for Oregon Emergency Response System (OERS) transfer
- Align positions into appropriate program budgets

Build statewide emergency framework

- Coordination Center staffing for response and training exercises
- Regional coordination alignment
- Recovery funding audit and monitoring
- Support diversity and equity work to provide culturally specific communications
- Fund shift staffing for state emergencies





Oregon Department of Emergency Management Governor's Budget Investments

Continue conversations on statewide risk reduction

- 25% state match for 75% Federal Funding on mitigation projects
- Carry forward remaining Other Funds expenditure limitation for \$20.0 million onetime mitigation investment made in 2021-23 (deposited in the Oregon Local Disaster Loan and Grant account)





Oregon Department of Emergency Management Reductions

Reductions

- Abolish one unfilled position in Administration
- Reduce inflationary increase on Services and Supplies funding
