Attached are recommendations from the Legislative Fiscal Office for the Board of Chiropractic Examiners.

The 2023-25 recommended budget for the Board of Chiropractic Examiners is \$2,604,293 Other Funds and six positions (5.75 FTE). The recommended budget is projected to leave the Board with an ending balance equivalent to 3.1 months of operating funds.

These recommendations account for a 20% fee increase effective July 1, 2023, and include the following Policy Option Packages:

- Package 100: Database Implementation and Maintenance
- Package 101: Healthcare Investigator from 0.60 FTE to 1.00 FTE
- Package 102: Reclassification of Administrative Support 2 to Program Analyst
- Package 103: Reclassification of Office Specialist 1 to Office Specialist 2 and an increase from 0.75 FTE to 1.00 FTE
- Package 104: Transition to DAS IT Support
- Package 105: Increase in Board Member per diem
