Measure Description:

Establishes Wallowa Rural and Recreational Economic Development Board.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Economic Development and Small Business to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure establishes the Wallowa Rural and Recreational Economic Development Board and appropriates \$5 million General Fund to focus on workforce development, workforce housing, and economic development in the Wallowa Rural and Recreational Economic Development Region.

A more complete fiscal analysis of the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
