Measure Description:

Grants to South Suburban Sanitary District exclusive right to use and sell treated wastewater discharged by district into Klamath River or tributaries.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Water Resources Department, Department of Environmental Quality, Department of Fish and Wildlife, Special Districts Association of Oregon, Counties

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Agriculture, Land Use, Natural Resources, and Water to the House Committee on Rules.

The measure grants the South Suburban Sanitary District the exclusive right to use treated wastewater discharged by the district into the Klamath River or any of its tributaries for the benefit of the district or for the general use and benefit of people or fish and wildlife. The discharge of treated wastewater must comply with requirements of a permit issued by the Department of Environmental Quality; and before using treated wastewater for the benefit of the district, the district must file a notice with the Water Resources Department.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Rules.
