**Measure Description:**

Provides that person who contracts with public body to provide services for purposes of community restoration or to restore fitness to proceed is state officer, employee or agent for purposes of indemnification under Oregon Tort Claims Act under certain circumstances.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Judicial Department, Psychiatric Security Review Board, Department of Justice, Oregon Health Authority

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Judiciary to the Senate Committee on Rules.

The measure provides that a person who contracts with a public body to provide services for community restoration or to restore fitness to proceed is a state officer, employee, or agent for purposes of indemnification under the Oregon Tort Claims Act for certain claims involving injury or death. The measure is effective January 1, 2024.
