Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

House Bill 3198, as amended by the -3 amendments, establishes the Early Literacy Success Initiative, including the Early Literacy Success School Grant, the Birth Through Five Literacy Plan, and the Early Literacy Success Community Grant program. The measure establishes the Birth through Five Literacy Fund and appropriates a blank amount of General Fund to the Department of Early Learning and Care to implement and administer the program. The measure establishes the Early Literacy Success Community Grant Fund and appropriates a blank amount of General Fund to the Department of Early Learning and Care to implement and administer the program. The measure establishes the Early Literacy Success Community Grant Fund and appropriates a blank amount of General Fund to the Oregon Department of Education to implement and administer the program.
