Measure Description:

Establishes the Youth in Custody Health Services Advisory Committee in the Oregon Health Authority.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Counties, Oregon Health Authority, Department of Human Services, Oregon Youth Authority, Department of Education

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Judiciary to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure establishes the Youth in Custody Health Services Advisory Committee within the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) and requires the Director of OHA to appoint 14 members to the Committee. No later than September 1 of even-numbered years, the measure requires the Committee to submit a report and recommendations to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly. The measure is effective January 1, 2024.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
