Measure Description:

Extends three parts of the Forest Products Harvest Tax through 2024 and 2025. Sets the tax rates for the purposes of funding OSU Forest Research, administering the Forest Practices Act, and funding OSU Forestry education at \$0.90, \$2.07, and \$.21 per MBF, respectively.

Impact Explanation:

The Forest Products Harvest tax extension is applied to tax years 2024 and 2025. The estimates are based on the timber harvest forecast included in the March Economic & Revenue forecast produced by the Office of Economic Analysis. The estimates include one quarter delay in collections compared to applicability.
