HB 5007 is the budget bill for the Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners. The sevenmember consumer protection and licensing board regulates the practice of chiropractic doctors and certified chiropractic assistants.

The Subcommittee recommends a budget of \$2,604,293 Other Funds which includes six positions, equivalent to 5.75 FTE. The budget includes a 20% fee increase, effective July 1, 2023, that will leave the Board with an operating fund balance of approximately 3 months. The budget increases the Healthcare Investigator to full-time and reclassifies two existing positions due to increased workload. Additional expenditure limitation is provided for implementation of a licensing database and the Board's transition to the Department of Administrative Services for IT Desktop Support.

The Education Subcommittee recommends HB 5007 be amended by the – 1 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
