

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

HB 5007 Board of Chiropractic Examiners

HB 5007 is the budget bill for the Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners. The seven-member consumer protection and licensing board regulates the practice of chiropractic doctors and certified chiropractic assistants.

The Subcommittee recommends a budget of \$2,604,293 Other Funds which includes six positions, equivalent to 5.75 FTE. The budget includes a 20% fee increase, effective July 1, 2023, that will leave the Board with an operating fund balance of approximately 3 months. The budget increases the Healthcare Investigator to full-time and reclassifies two existing positions due to increased workload. Additional expenditure limitation is provided for implementation of a licensing database and the Board's transition to the Department of Administrative Services for IT Desktop Support.

The Education Subcommittee recommends HB 5007 be amended by the – 1 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
