Oregon Statewide Educator Survey Initiative

- Online, anonymous school survey for all school-based, licensed educators (teachers, administrators, school
 personnel) at all school districts and charter schools in the state
- Nationally normed survey questions on educator perceptions of school-level conditions relating to
 Professional Development, Equitable Access, School Leadership, Instructional Practices and Support, Behavior
 Management, New Teacher and Principal Support
- Administered by a national vendor in partnership with Oregon's state and local education agencies, with results publicly available for use by schools, districts, state agencies, and researchers
- Resources, including toolkits and professional learning opportunities, on strategies for using survey results to inform school improvement efforts aligned to state policy
- Participation in the survey helps determine whether educators in schools and districts across the state have the resources and supports necessary to provide the most effective teaching and learning environment for students
- Survey results are used to **inform continuous improvement in schools and districts** and plan for **resources and supports** at the local and state policy levels

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- TELL Survey administered by Chief Education Office every two years from 2014 to 2018;
 re-launched by Educator Advancement Council in 2023
- Partners have included OEA, COSA, OSBA, OAESD, Chalkboard Project (now Foundations for a Better Oregon), ODE and Governor's Office
- Paused in 2020 due to pandemic; re-launched and refined using input and feedback from advisory groups from across the state in 2023 as part of a multi-year project to improve data collection and reporting to be responsive to local and regional needs
- 20% 50% of all school-based, licensed educators participating each year; participation varies significantly across the state with lower participation among rural school and districts
- Current survey **does not include all education staff:** district-level staff and classified staff largest groups not served



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Changes to the survey in 2023:

- Shorter Survey: Now about half the length of the prior survey
- Relevance: Gathered feedback from advisory groups; Prioritized questions based on relevance and through application of equity lens
- Defined Purpose: With the help of advisors,
 re-defined the purpose and scope
- Demographic Questions: Added optional demographics questions about race/ethnicity and gender identity

Future Areas of Improvement:

- Expand & tailor survey tool(s) to meet needs
 of all educator groups (including district-level,
 classified staff, and substitutes)
- Align survey administration timeline to state, district, and school improvement planning
- Continue to develop survey items that compliment state, regional, and local data collection efforts
- Strengthen partnerships that inform survey design, implementation, and data use





What's Happening Next

- Survey administered from mid-February to mid-March
- Survey results available in early to mid-June
- Planning sessions around data use & learning with advisory groups and partners
- Follow-up with districts, regions, & stakeholders
