WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Eliminates distributions from the State School Fund for facility grants. Carves out no more than \$3 million per biennium from the State School Fund to help improve safety and security of students and staff. First applies to the 2023-24 State School Fund distributions.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

This measure eliminates facility grants (up to \$3 million per biennium) and redirects the money (no more than \$3 million per biennium) for school safety and security, thus removing one grant and creating a new carve-out in the State School Fund distributions.

Under current law, facility grants are part of the grants to school districts and the grants are funded from the school district share of the formula revenue. This measure abolishes facility grants. The measure also specifies that the new safety and security carve-out come directly from the State School Fund (or the common pool of the formula revenue to be distributed to school districts and education service districts).
