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#### Measure Description:

Modifies statutory provisions relating to school nutrition, speech-language pathology programs, investigations of sexual conduct or abuse, issuing subpoenas, the role of education service districts in the Student Success Act, and the intensive program for high-needs school districts. Modifies statutory provisions relating to investigations to refer to conduct, not individuals. Specifies that student success teams are not government bodies subject to any statutes or rules applicable to public bodies. Specifies that school districts that do not accept recommendations of a student success team are not eligible for additional funding under the intensive program.
