Subject: HB 2013 – Relating to alcohol Work Session Recommendations

HB 2013 A permits malt beverages, wine, and cider products to be directly delivered to a retailer in Oregon who holds a direct shipper permit issued by the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission (OLCC). The measure brings statute into conformity with a legal settlement reached between the OLCC and out of state beverage distributors. The measure passed out of the House Committee on Economic Development and Small Business on April 4, 2023 with a unanimous "do pass" recommendation.

### **Recommended Changes**

LFO recommends adoption of the –A4 amendment. The -A4 amendment includes a technical conforming statutory reference recommended by Legislative Counsel, and provides \$175,000 Other Funds expenditure limitation to the OLCC to modify its existing IT system to capture filings of reports on the quantity of beverages shipped.

MOTION: I move adoption of the –A4 amendment to HB 2013. (VOTE)
