




Oregon's recovery and expansion tracked the national trend, but lagged behind by a few months






Most of Oregon's metro areas expanding, meanwhile Lane and Medford continue to recover





Oregon's rural communities much more resilient compared to recent recessions












Inflation turned wage gains negative, but 3-year gains remain above the long-term trend
