Subject: $\quad$ SB 1048 - Relating to Department of Transportation Small Business Assistance Program Work Session Recommendations

SB 1048 directs the Department of Transportation (ODOT) to develop a small business assistance program to promote equity and to assist small and minority and women-owned businesses in competing for contracting opportunities. Policy Option Package 105 is included in ODOT's budget bill, providing 3 positions ( 2.30 FTE ) and associated expenditure limitation in the amount of $\$ 672,044$ in associated expenditure limitation to accommodate the new program.

## Recommended Changes

LFO recommends adoption of the -A3 amendment, which specifies the aggregate amount of public improvement contracts into which ODOT may enter under the small business development program established by the bill.
